Products and Services:

Newgene's flagship product is the sterile 1ml hypodermic syringe, featuring:

- A rubber stopper with an extension to minimize waste.
- A cylinder with a clear scale and safety markings.

- A high-resistance plunger.
- A Luer slip tip for secure needle attachment.

The company's production facility includes a controlled environment certified to ISO 8 standards, ensuring the highest quality and safety in manufacturing processes.
